


CHARACTERISTICS OF HOUSING ADVICE

- Range of services: consultations on furnishings, conversions, extensions and additions, refurbishment, advice on technology, tools and aids, applications and financing



- Care networks identified using the example of three districts in southern Brandenburg
- Structures of housing advice in Brandenburg incompletely surveyable
- Housing advice primarily located in nursing support points
- Networking of all stakeholders in the region is essential

NEXT STEPS

- Combining social expertise and knowledge from different specialist fields
- Using synergy effects for sustainable advise
- Interdisciplinary negotiation processes with the aim of maximizing quality of life and autonomy
- Development of a customized and professional housing advise concept
