Cryptography (SS 2020) - Guidelines for the Exam -

The exam takes place at Friday, 24th of July, 08:30am to 10:30am in room ZHG Audimax 2. Due to the particular circumstances we are facing these days, we kindly ask you to respect the following additional hints.

- 1. Please, arrive 15 minutes earlier. We will open the lecture hall at 08:15am.
- 2. Use only the ground level door as the **entrance** of Audimax 2. **Leave** Audimax 2 only via the back door which can be found upstairs at the back wall of the lecture hall. This order covers **toilet breaks** as well.
- 3. While waiting in front of the lecture hall until taking a seat within Audimax 2, please, wear a **mouth-nose cover**. You may take it off during the examination. Put it on again when a lecturer comes to you or when leaving the lecture hall. Keep a **distance of at least 1.50 meters** from other people while waiting or taking a seat.
- 4. In Audimax 2, those **seats** where you are allowed to sit **are marked with an envelope** which contains the exam. Please, only use seats marked in this way. **Do not touch** the envelope until the exam starts officially. Otherwise, this will be interpreted as an **attempt to defraud** and you will fail the exam, automatically.
- 5. After taking a seat, please, put your **student's card** to a desk next to you. We need to check them before the exam starts.
- 6. When you finish your exam, put all the documents (task sheet, your solutions, auxiliary calculations, etc.) into the envelope and leave it at your seat while you leave Audimax 2 via the back door. If you happen to have an own stapling machine, we would appreciate if you bring it with you and tack your material after the exam before putting it into the envelope. Otherwise, we will do it later on.
- 7. Request getaways to the bathroom via a hand sign during the examination and wait for a response of one of the lecturers.

Some other hints regarding the actual exam are listed below.

- 1. Keep writing paper ready, we will not provide any paper.
- 2. You are allowed to bring with you two handwritten standard A4 pages of notes (either the front and the back of a single sheet of paper OR (exclusive OR) the fronts of two sheets of paper).
- 3. The use of electronic devices like calculators, smart watches, or smartphones is not allowed during the exam. The use of other additional supplementary material like your lecture notes or text books is also illegal.
- 4. If necessary, we will equip you with a Vigenère table.
- 5. Write your name clearly on each sheet of paper.
- 6. Be aware of the fact that the exam has an obligatory part and an open option part. Read the tasks carefully.

The 'Studierendenservice' informed us that students with the subsequently stated matriculation numbers are officially registered for the exam. Only registered students are allowed to take the exam. If your number is missing on the list, although you think that you are registered, then contact your 'Studiengangsbearbeiter' in the 'Studierendenservice'.
