As part of an innovative educational model Kiron offers coherent curricula using MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) from partner platforms like Coursera and edX so that refugees can start studying regardless of their status. Courses are mostly provided in English, completely free of charge for the students and all accessible via our learning platform Kiron Campus. To support the learning outcomes of its students, Kiron also offers a Direct Academics programme which mainly consists of synchronous teaching & learning formats such as small-group online tutorials. Tutorials accompany a specific MOOC or module, fulfill a specific learning objective in their study track, or foster key skills such as academic writing. The Direct Academics programme is entirely supported by volunteer instructors who are professionals or experts in their field and wish to supply and/or gain more experience in online education and refugee issues.

- Some teaching experience preferred, e.g. as a student tutor or a lecturer
- Minimum C1 English skills, German and/or Arabic are an asset
- Familiarity with MOOCs, Google Classroom, and Google Hangouts is helpful (but we are here to support you!)
