- Outgoing mobilities to the above-mentioned regions can only be realised for doctoral students
- Incoming mobilities are possible for Bachelor's, Master's and doctoral students

Top-Up amount:

The criteria for applying for additional financial support for students with disability or chronic illness, students with children, first-time graduates or working students are defined by <u>DAAD</u>.

Staff mobility:

- Mobility period of at least 5 days up to a maximum of 60 days
- Staff exchange for outgoing and incoming possible

Travel allowance and additional travelling days:

- For student and staff mobilities, a one-off travel allowance is paid depending on the one-way distance between the place of origin and the destination
