



Information sheet Financial support

In general, all participants of the ERASMUS + study abroad programme will receive financial support intended for related costs in a foreign country. Condition to this is that the student is enrolled in a degree programme in Germany, which will lead to a recognized qualification and has already completed at least one academic year of said degree programme.

The amount of funding for all host countries amounts to **700 € per month**. The maximum number of months is agreed upon in the inter-institutional agreement with the respective partner university. In addition to the monthly scholarship there will also be a **one time travel lump-sum**. The amount varies depending on the host country.

The disbursement of funding is generally paid out in two instalments: at the beginning of the study abroad and after returning in the presence of all necessary documents.

The ERASMUS+ coordinators at the International Relations Office of the BTU Cottbus – Senftenberg will inform you before and during your semester abroad about all the necessary steps and formalities.

Special support for students with special needs

Students with disabilities may receive an allowance for additional costs in the context of an ERASMUS+ term abroad. In such as case, please contact the Coordinator of the ERASMUS+ Student Mobility at the International Relations Office of the BTU Cottbus - Senftenberg.
