Participants in the ERASMUS+ programme are exempt from tuition fees at the host university and receive mobility funding from the European Commission. The stay abroad is possible from the first semester of a Bachelor's degree onwards, knowledge of the teaching language according to the requirements of the host university is desired (see column "Teaching Languages").

The places announced are agreed between the departments of the BTU and the host university; it is therefore not possible to apply for places from other departments. After the BTU-internal selection procedure, the nomination is made at the host university, the final decision on admission is then made by the host university.
