As part of the EU Erasmus+ education programme, the LEONARDO-Office Brandenburg promotes internships abroad for students from participating universities and universities of applied sciences in Brandenburg.

ERASMUS+ TIME QUOTA

After successfully applying for the current study cycle (bachelor's, master's), all students have an Erasmus+ time quota of 360 days at their disposal. This can be used for an Erasmus+ study programme or internship during the respective study cycle.

The funding can be divided and used multiple times within a study cycle.



INTERNSHIP DURATION

- Long-Term: 60 - 365 days
- Short-Term: 5 - 30 days



APPLICATION DEADLINE

- Without internship placement: Earliest 6 months before start
- with internship placement: latest 2 months before start



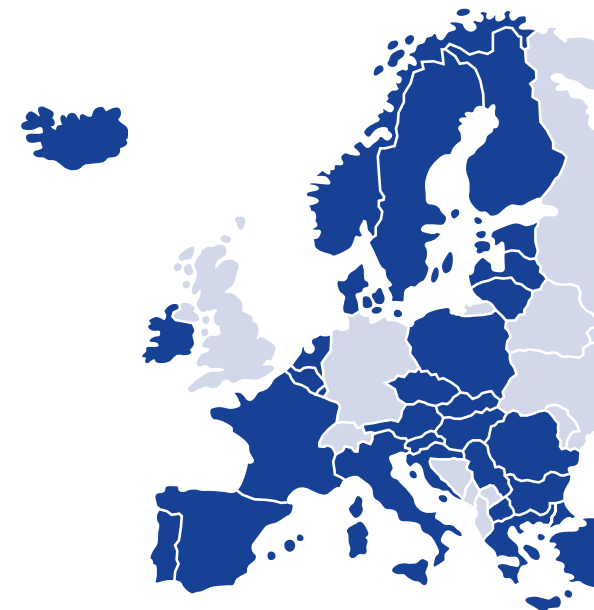
PREREQUISITE

- enrollment as a student
- language skills in the working language
- Erasmus+ time quota



REQUIREMENTS

- full-time internship (min. 35 h per week)
- related to your studies
- physical internship abroad



FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

The programme provides beneficiaries with a monthly allowance to cover living expenses abroad and supports them during their preparations:

- financial subsidies dependent on the destination country
- academic recognition of the internship
- support in organising your stay abroad
- if applicable, a subsidised online language course as part of the Online Language Support (OLS)
- if applicable, additional subsidies (special needs; use of sustainable means of transport; etc.)
