# **Project Background**

This tender concerns the second phase of the project titled "Bazar Abbas – Recovery Lab of Port Said", funded by the British Council's Cultural Protection Fund in partnership with the UK Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport. While the broader project focuses on the urban recovery of Port Said's inner city, the current phase concentrates on stabilizing the structure of Bazar Abbas in preparation for future rehabilitation. This includes addressing critical structural issues and initiating targeted reconstruction efforts. These efforts include:

#### • Structural Stabilization

This component aims to ensure the long-term stability of the structure, safeguard users, and mitigate the risk of further deterioration. Key interventions will include addressing issues such as foundation settlement, soil displacement, erosion, and water ingress. Specific works will involve underpinning, reinforcing compromised structural elements (including walls, columns, beams, and floors), and implementing temporary supports such as shoring and scaffolding. All restoration activities will adhere to conservation standards, using historically appropriate materials and methods.

## **Scope of Contractor Services**

- Document existing conditions and prepare technical reports with recommendations.
- Foundation and soil stabilization.
- Reinforce or repair compromised structural elements such as walls, columns, beams, and floors.
- Use compatible and historically appropriate materials following conservation standards.





- Temporary structural support in some areas if needed, including shoring, bracing, and scaffolding.
- Maintain the safety of the structure and site during restoration.
- Waterproofing and drainage mitigation by implementing systems or repairs to control water ingress.
- Improve drainage around foundations to prevent future issues.
- Coordinate with heritage consultants or regulatory bodies.

### **Further Points of Consideration**

- A site visit will be arranged for shortlisted contractors to facilitate a comprehensive understanding of the project scope. Accommodation expenses, if necessary, will be covered.
- A comprehensive work package—including detailed plans, 3D models, and a risk
  assessment—will be provided to shortlisted applicants. Please note that any use of
  these materials outside the scope of this project or without prior authorization will be
  subject to legal action.

### **Contractor Profile**

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a legally registered entity (Egyptian or international) with a valid tax number.
- Be able to issue official stamped and signed invoices.
- Have at least 10 years of experience in structural projects, especially in stabilization.
- Capacity for technical and regulatory engagement in heritage contexts is preferred.

## **Application Process**

- Interested applicants must submit an Expression of Interest via email, including:
  - 1. A brief outline of proposed approach and framework
  - 2. A short CV
  - 3. A brief portfolio
- Shortlisted applicants will receive a work package and be invited to visit the site.
- Shortlisted applicants must then submit a formal proposal, including:
  - A concise technical approach detailing the proposed structural stabilization methods and materials, based on the provided documentation and insights from the site visit. The approach should demonstrate an understanding of traditional construction techniques and structural safety considerations.
  - 2. A timeline and work plan
  - 3. A detailed fee proposal
