


City of Poznan



Poznan is the fifth-largest and one of the oldest cities in Poland. As of 2019, the city's population is 534,813, while the Poznan metropolitan area comprising Poznan County and several other communities is inhabited by over 1 million people. It is the historical capital of the Greater Poland region and is currently the administrative capital of the province called Greater Poland Voivodeship. Poznan is a center of trade, sports, education, technology and tourism. It is an important academic site, with about 130,000 students.




















