GUIDANCE DEUTSCHLANDSTIPENDIUM APPLICATION FOR PROLONGATION

General Information

Every Deutschlandstipendium scholarship recipient with a year-long scholarship who fulfils the requirements may apply for an extension at the BTU office responsible for the scholarship programme. This applies to:

- An extension within the normal study 1. period (normal study period = maximum period of financial support):
- 2. An extension of the maximum period of financial support according to §7 of the "Law for the creation of a national scholarship programme (Scholarship Programme Law - StipG)";
- 3. An extension within the normal study period if prolonged due to involvement in student government;
- 4. A leave of absence for a study-related foreign residency, such as ERASMUS or STUDEXA.

Information on extending the maximum period of financial support according to §7 StipG

If the period of study is extended due to a serious reason, such as a handicap, preqnancy, caring for or raising a child, or participating in a study-related residence abroad, then the maximum period of financial support may be extended upon application.

Documents

- 1. informal application with justification for the period for which the extension is requested (maximum two semesters) (example: extension for the winter semester 20../.. and the summer semester 20.)
- 2. current overview of grades and current enrolment certificate (summer semester 20..)
- 3. unsolicited submission of the BTU Cottbus - Senftenberg certificate of enrollment for the following winter semester by August 15 of the year at the latest

- 4 confirmation from Student Services of the extension of the standard period of study due to activities in student self-administration
- 5. other certificates, such as confirmation of a handicap, pregnancy or parental leave
- 6. certificate for a residency abroad, such as with the ERASMUS or STUDEXA programmes.

Application

The application must be submitted by **April** 5 of the year at the latest (receipt of the email) - informally with reasons. Unfortunately, late and incomplete applications cannot be considered.

The minimum performance value is ≤ 2.5 .

Decision

Applicants receive written responses no later than September of the year in which applications for extensions were filed (financial support begins in October).

Extensions are permitted up to a **maximum** of two semesters when all of the requirements are fulfilled and on the condition that the necessary funds are authorized. It is possible to re-apply for an extension when one still fulfils the requirements. The extension comes into effect at the start of the following winter semester.

A scholarship ends in any case with the completion of a degree programme. Students who intend to join a master programme after completing the Bachelor degree have to apply for Deutschlandstipendium again.
