



Call for Applications Scholarship for Students of the Master Urban Design – Revitalization of Historic City Districts for Studying the Fourth Semester with BTU Cottbus-Senftenberg

- Admissible applicants: Students enrolled in the third semester of the Master's programme Urban Design – Revitalization of Historic City Districts at BTU Cottbus-Senftenberg
- Total number of scholarships: 2
- Duration of the scholarship: 1 April 2023 – 30 September 2023 (6 months)
- Purpose of the scholarships: Financial support for studying in the fourth semester with Brandenburg University of Technology in Cottbus, Germany
- Costs covered:
- Monthly allowance of 861 € per month (total over 6 months: 5166 €)
 - One-time travel allowance of 850 €
- Payment arrangements:
- Monthly allowance paid out at the beginning of each month
 - One-time travel allowance paid out at the beginning of the funding period or upon arrival in Germany
 - All payments to German bank accounts only
- Application documents:
- Letter of motivation (no more than 2500 characters)
 - Curriculum Vitae (1 page)
 - Portfolio of the work done during the previous three semesters of the programme (max. 5 pages)
- Application deadline: **26 February 2023**
Submit your complete application as one pdf-file (your last name as file name, max. file size 250 MB) via the respective [assignment submission tool](#) in the moodle course "Information for Students of Urban Design - Revitalization of Historic City Districts". Submission opens in January 2023 and closes on 26 February 2023 at 23:59.
Incomplete or late applications will be excluded.
- Selection criteria:
- Application documents (60 %):
 - Experience in identifying relevant urban development problems (10 %)
 - Experience in defining tasks, methods and strategies to solve problems (10 %)
 - Ability to design qualified concepts in a traceable way (40 %)
 - [Selection interview (40 %)]
- Interview: The top four applicants whose written application documents achieved the highest percentage will be invited to a personal interview in March 2023 (date to be determined). Applicants who are not invited for an interview will not be eligible for a scholarship. (The selection committee re-
